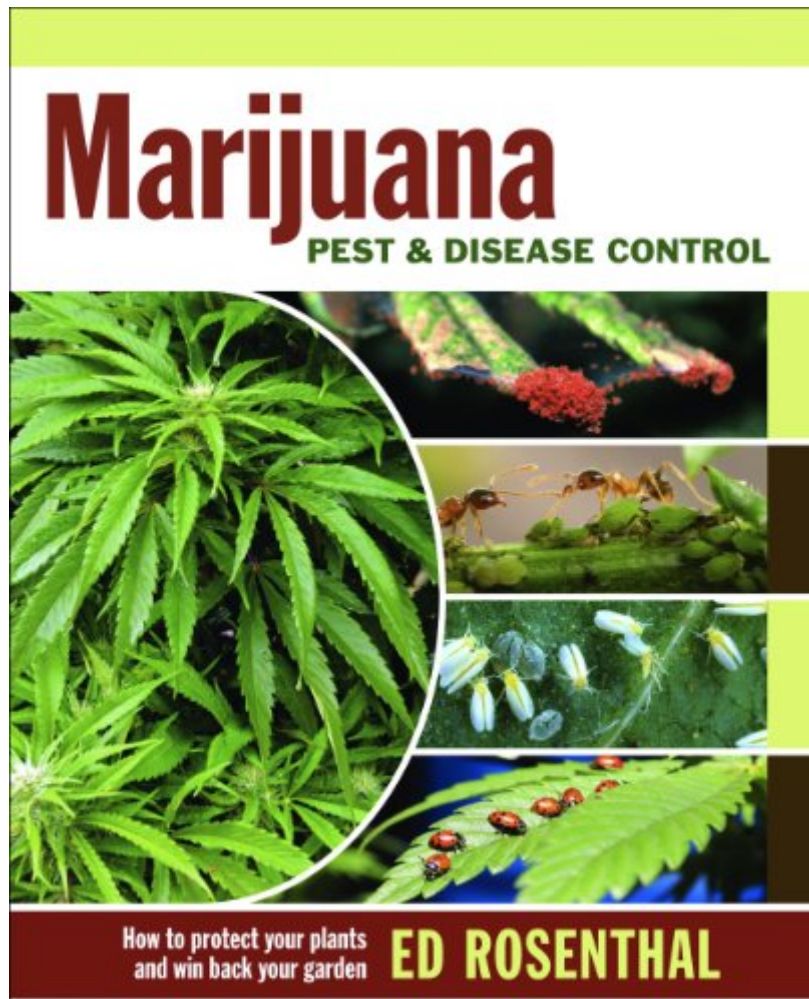

structure of the book is more geared to Ed's passionate interest in the bugs themselves, and he really does not provide an easy-to-use reference for those who are just trying to raise a plant or two for personal use. I'd like to see the book reformatted, with the entomology lessons in the front section and the reference tables and photographs in a dedicated section in the back.

This book is truly a wealth of info. Dr. Rosenthal really does a nice job on this book. My biggest issue with this book is that it has very few color pictures that are color to help ID young pests. A black and white sketch is great if you really have a solid amount of experience, yet I have a fair amount and I found it a bit hard to use it that regard. But, the info. and everything else about this book is GREAT!! If it had the color pics in diff. growth stages (Pests) I would have had ZERO issue with giving it a 5 star rating.
