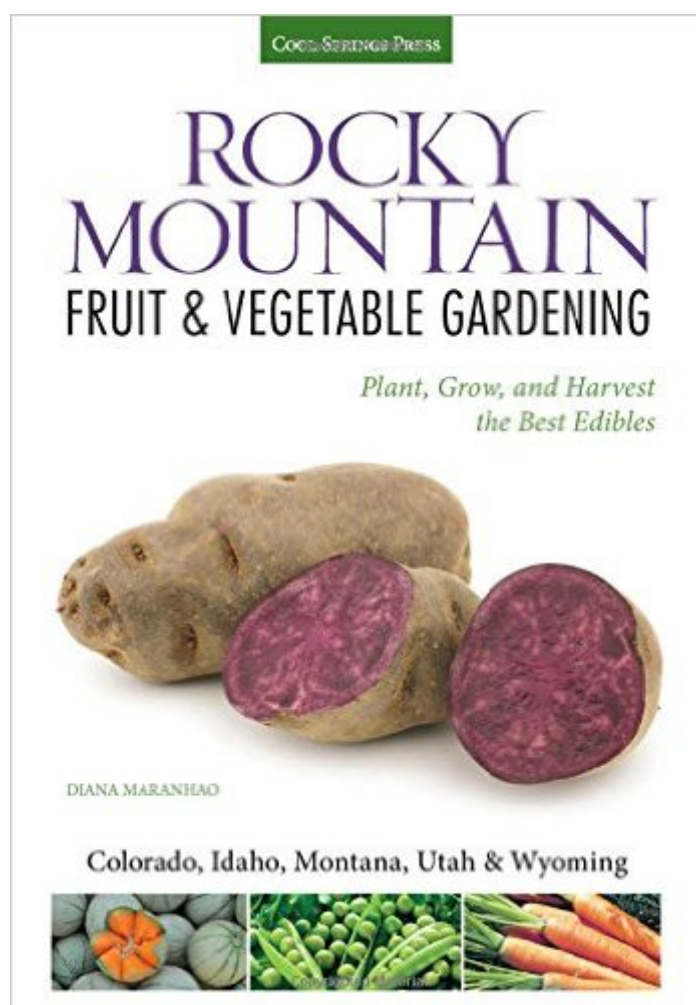

Pretty helpful but has a few flaws which is why I took away a star. The first part is general gardening information slanted towards this region. The second part is individual plant profiles with helpful information like when to plant, days to maturity, good companion plants, varieties that do well with our short growing season and little helpful tips about each plant. One of the flaws is that occasionally the book will give unclear info on just when to plant outdoors when starting from seeds indoors. It will say to start seeds indoors x weeks ahead of when you intend to transplant them outdoors but doesn't tell you when exactly when that is. That's just on a few plants though. Overall, it's been quite helpful in helping me plan for my first garden this Spring.
