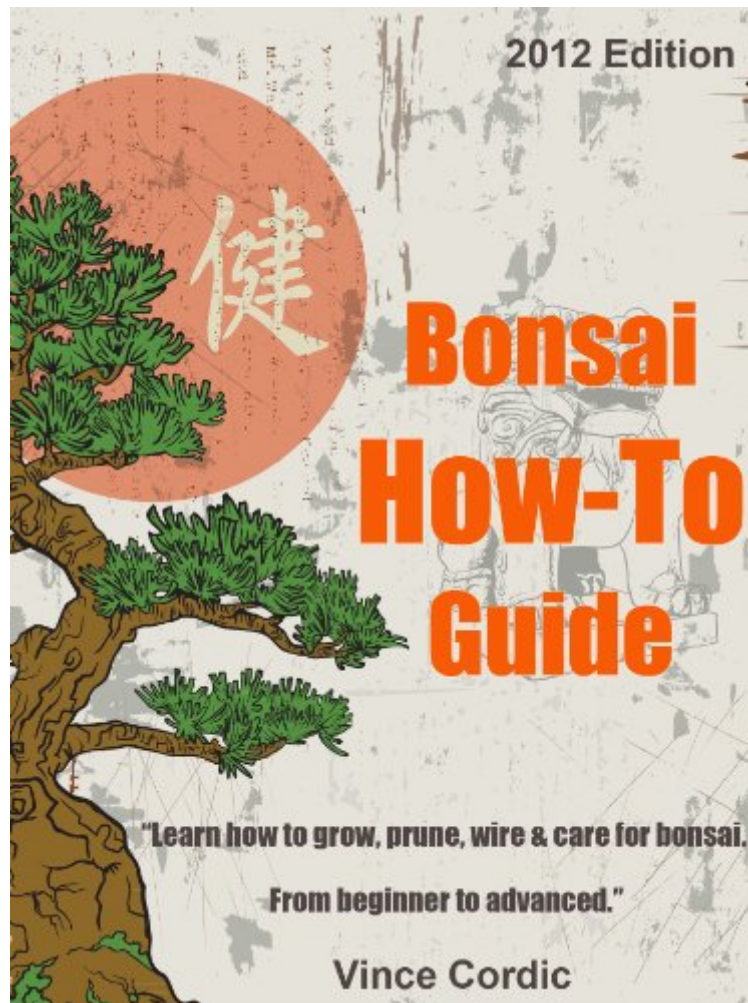


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Ultimate Bonsai How To Guide - 2012 Edition



Synopsis

This book will guide the beginner bonsai enthusiast in all aspects of creating their own miniature gardens which will leave them with a feeling of accomplishment and we are sure, many comments and questions from others who will appreciate the time and dedication that you have put into creating such a masterpiece. It will guide you through all the stages of developing many different types of bonsai, including miniature bonsai gardens, mame bonsai (being the smallest of the bonsai group), weeping and cascading bonsais, outdoor and indoor bonsais, and rock bonsais, to name only a few of the many varieties. It begins with a brief history of the bonsai, goes on to list the various types of bonsais, how to choose the bonsai best for you (whether it be growing from seed, from the wild, a nursery, or perhaps from a planting you already have in your yard). It will help you in mixing the special bonsai soil mixtures, the techniques for planting and pruning of bonsais, wiring techniques for bonsais, and an instructional guide for the most popular bonsais which informs you as to when to fertilize your bonsai (and what type of fertilizer to use), when to debut your bonsai, transplant your bonsai, trim the root ball of your bonsai and what to watch for with respect to parasites and diseases that may afflict your bonsai. There is also a watering guide for bonsai, an all important factor considering the small amount of soil used in a bonsai planting, and when, where and how they should be maintained in each season of the year. There is also an important section which deals with propagation of your bonsai, whether it is by way of grafting, air or ground layered or by way of seeds or cuttings. If you wish to know how to prematurely age your bonsai (â œjinâ •) this book simplifies the manner in which to do so such that your planting, which may only be 2 or 3 years old, can be aged to look many years older. In essence, this book explains most, if not all, of the bonsai basics and can turn you into someone whose hobby can become creation of these exquisite, miniature wonders which resemble their giant friends of nature but can be kept on your own kitchen window.

I'm happy to say that it was well worth it, and after reading it I have already started on my first bonsai. This book covers pretty much every subject you could want if you are just getting started with bonsai, as well as some more advanced subjects (like bonsai jin & shari). A few of the advanced topics could be more in depth, as they are glanced over as to not overwhelm the reader. I almost like it better that way, so I don't get confused right out of the gates. I would definitely recommend this book for a beginner to intermediate bonsai hobbyist. If you already have all the basics nailed down you might still pick up a few tips but it is definitely written for new comers to the hobby (which is a good thing).

I found this book full on good, clearly written advice on the basics of not killing your bonsai, and plenty of tips for making them look as beautiful as possible. The photos and diagrams were well chosen, too. My one wish is that it were a little longer and more in-depth on the process of actually beginning a bonsai from scratch.
